LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE FOR PRIMARY ELECTION
JULY 20, 2026

In order to be eligible to vote in the Primary Election you must file a completed **Florida Voter Registration Application** by **July 20, 2026**.

When the registration books are closed for an election, updates to a voter's name, address, and signature pursuant to ss. 98.077 and 101.045 shall be the only changes permitted for purposes of the upcoming election.

**FLORIDA IS A CLOSED PRIMARY &
UNIVERSAL PRIMARY CONTEST STATE**

Closed Primary State: This means that only voters who are registered members of a political party may vote for their respective party's candidates in a Primary Election.

Universal Primary Contest: If all candidates for an office have the same party affiliation and the winner will have no opposition in the General Election, all qualified voters, regardless of party affiliation, may vote in the Primary Election for that office. This is known as a "Universal Primary Contest." On the August 18, 2026 Primary Election ballot, there is ONE Universal Primary Contest as well as TWO nonpartisan races that are applicable to all registered voters, regardless of party affiliation:

County Commissioner, District 4 - Universal Primary Contest
County Court Judge, Group 1 - Non Partisan
School Board, District 3 - Non Partisan

Know your party affiliation before you vote!!! Party changes must be made by July 20, 2026 in order for the change to be effective for this Primary Election.

HAS YOUR SIGNATURE CHANGED?

With the 2026 elections fast approaching it's important that you update your signature if you haven't done so already. Signatures can change over time due to aging or medical conditions. When there are significant changes to your signature or identifying "mark" you need to update that signature with our office.

- ◆ Apply through any of these agencies while accessing their services:
 - * Florida driver license office. You also have the option to submit voter registration information online when you renew your driver license online through the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles' online renewal system. For more information, visit GoRenew.com.
 - * Tax collector's office that issues driver licenses or Florida identification cards
 - * Voter registration agencies: Public Assistance offices, Offices that provide state funded programs for persons with disabilities, Armed Forces Recruitment Offices, Centers for Independent Living and Public Libraries.
 - * Paper application forms may be found at any county Supervisor of Elections office, local library, or any entity authorized by the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission to issue fishing, hunting, or trapping permits. The form contains detailed information on how to submit the form.
